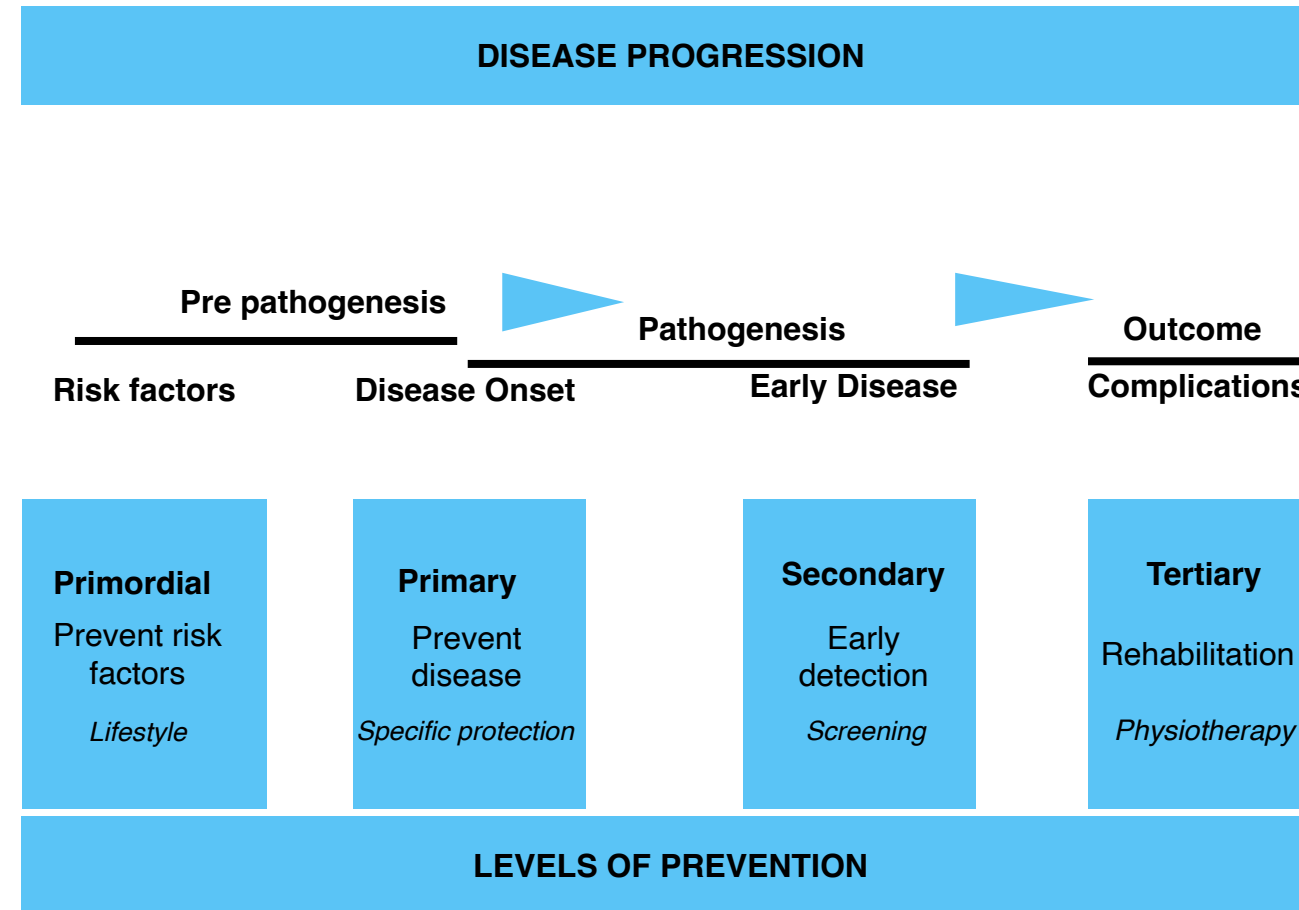


Aligned with natural history of disease

**DEFINITION**

Levels of prevention are interventions applied at different stages of disease progression to prevent occurrence, halt progression, and reduce disability. (Leavell & Clark)
